## Tactical Hapkido may air on the Discovery Channel next year!



**Exclusive!** No one else has word of this in any other Tactical Hapkido school.

The online series BEST DEFENSE, with Darryl Johnson is currently working on getting a pilot program to compete with Human Weapon and Fight Quest but from a different perspective for 2009.

The format of the proposed show is as follows: Individuals who are handicapped in wheel chairs, blind, elderly or women and children encounter situations where they are attacked on the street.

At this point the show freezes and the question is asked: What can the master's do to help the person in this situation? The show then splits to how that individual was trained in the martial arts by the master.

After this segment the show picks up at the point it froze and the individual defends themselves using what they learned.

Since the Tactical Hapkido Alliance has been involved in the Best Defense Series, Darryl Johnson has offered Master Ziots, Master Brown or Grandmaster Rodemaker to be an associate producer of this show if the pilot program is received well by the network. At this point a final decision of who will work on this has not been met, but we will update you on any more developments as they come up.
